Dear Parishioners,

Following Pentecost, as we enter into “Ordinary Time” so many feasts come flooding in. This is now the time of the Church. Jesus has said “over to you, now. You continue the work that I began. I have shown you how, and given you the power you need through the Holy Spirit”. This Sunday is the Solemnity of the Most Holy and Undivided Trinity. God has now completed the revelation of himself and we enter into this great mystery. The most important thing about the Christian discipleship is to know your self and to know God.

The next Sunday is the Solemnity of the Body & Blood of Christ when we thank God for the great Sacrament that is at the centre of our ongoing Christian discipleship. Last week I forwarded a link to you to enable to watch a documentary about Blessed Carlo Acutis. He was a young boy born in 1991 who died suddenly in 2006 from a very aggressive form of leukemia. He had a remarkable love for Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, a love that spread out from his life to many people from very different backgrounds and religions. Do watch it. It is only available until 31 May which is this Monday! I am sure it will set you alight with that love too.

The following Friday is the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, a feast that is so dear to us. It is the day for our Exposition in Church. We shall have Mass at 10.00 am followed by Exposition of

the Blessed Sacrament until Mass at 7.00 pm. I have put a list at the back of the Church. Please sign up for the time you can be there. We must have someone there all the time. The last few years we have relied on Sr. Meena and Sehion ministry to cover the gaps, but we can't do that now.

Trinity Sunday

(Deuteronomy 4:32-34, 39-40 Romans 8:14-17 Matthew 28:16-20) *The Blessed Trinity is an intimate love relationship:* Jesus summarises the commandments: love God and your neighbour. The intimacy of married love has this high calling: wholly love God and love each other, we are one another's closest neighbour. It is said that married love most closely reveals the love relationships in the Trinity: three persons in one God, calls us to be two persons in one flesh.

Corpus Christi (Exodus 24: 3-8 Hebrews 9: 11-15 Mark 14: 12-16, 22-26) *A promise of eternal life.* Today, the letter to the Hebrews speaks of a new covenant, a new promise of eternal life. We became a new covenant when we promised to be a married couple on our wedding day. We renew

our married covenant each time we nourish and feed each other in our relationship with acts and words of tender kindness.

The Sacred Heart of Jesus (Hosea 11:1, 3-4, 8-9 Ephesians 3:8-12, 14-19 John 19:31-37) Tender, loving, forgiveness, even when we walk away Hosea extols the tender love of God: a father leading a child beginning to walk '*with strings of love...*' Then, like many parents, God watched His children '*do their own thing*' and suffer the consequences. Jesus' heart was pierced by the centurion's lance and blood and water flowed, symbolising God's tender loving forgiveness. In marriage, tender, loving forgiveness is essential.
