Dear Parishioners and Friends, This past week, I had the unexpected privilege of travelling to Spain – at very short notice – to represent the Archdiocese at the Funeral Mass of one of our Priests, Fr John Darley, who retired to Alicante, Spain, about 10 years ago. In the event of the death of the Priest of our Archdiocese outside the geography of our area, it is always appreciated when a priest of the Diocese can travel to be there. I only heard that he had died on Sunday morning, flew out to Spain on Tuesday morning; Funeral 11am Wednesday; Flew back to Birmingham on Thursday afternoon. Fr John Darley had ministered as a priest for 43 years before his retirement. May he rest in peace.
