Some sad news — Deacon Godlove Amungwa's father, Athanasius, has died in Cameroon. May he rest in peace. We pray for Deacon Godlove at this sad time.

As a result of this, Deacon Godlove's Ordination to the Priesthood which was scheduled to be in September has now been brought forward to Friday 21st July (next weekend!) at 7pm at Shrewsbury Cathedral.

We still plan to send a coach to the Ordination, but people need to know the timings: Coach leaves Sacred Heart at 3pm on Friday afternoon, then picks up at St Chad's Cathedral at 3.30pm. (Need to give time on a Friday evening)

The Ordination is at 7pm at Shrewsbury Cathedral. (until approx. 9pm)

There will be a Reception after the Ordination nearby.

The coach will leave Shrewsbury at 10pm prompt.
