Message from Father Tim .....

## Dear Parishioners and Friends,

When I was a child and into my teens, I didn't really get what all the fuss was about on Remembrance Sunday. It seemed irrelevant to me, what had happened in the past. The two World Wars seemed to be in the past and I didn't know why people wanted to keep talking about them. But in my lifetime, there has been the Falklands Conflict and all of the wars since which have made war and conflict very much a thing of the present, rather than of the past. A visit to the National Memorial Arboretum in Staffordshire is both thought-provoking and humbling. The loss of life of such young people in war often begs the question: Why? Today, we Remember, because people who make sacrifices for others deserve not to be forgotten. And in the Eucharist, we Remember and make present the sacrifice of Christ. On this Remembrance Sunday, let us pray for Peace in the World.
