### **Receiving Holy Communion**

We welcome all visitors and those who do not regularly worship with us at Sacred Heart Church. If you are not a Catholic, or are a Catholic who does not receive Holy Communion, you are welcome to come forward for a prayer of blessing. If you would like to receive a prayer of blessing, please fold your arms across your chest in the form of a cross and the Priest or Minister will give you a prayer of blessing. A gentle reminder that if receiving Holy Communion in the hand, it should be received in <u>two hands</u> – one on top of the other. And you should place the host in your mouth immediately, and not walk away with it, for any reason. Thank you.
